

Specialty Classes:

Reactive Dog Class

Entry Requirements: Any dog that is reactive to other dogs and/ or people to the extent that the dog cannot be incorporated into a regular obedience or agility class because of their behaviour issues.

Exit Criteria: The dog is biddable to re-direction and has a level of self-control around other dogs and people so that it can be integrated into a regular class setting.

Description: This low enrolment class will provide safe and controlled situations that will address issues arising from lack of confidence, impulse control, and/ or anxiety issues. Through a combination of relaxation techniques and providing increasingly challenging scenarios while keeping the dog below threshold, we work towards either changing your dog's emotional response or training incompatible behaviours.

Competitive Leash Work:

Entry Requirements: Attentive Heeling or Level Two Obedience

Exit Goal: To be able to compete in Rally Novice Obedience or Pre Novice Obedience

Description: This course is designed to give the dog and handler the skills required to do all Pre Novice exercises and all exercises required for Rally Novice

Introduction to Clicker Training:

Entry Requirements: Any dog/handler team looking for a fun positive training method

Exit Goal: Dog/Handler team will have acquired skills that they can use with their dog in all walks of life

Description: Clicker training is all about criteria, timing and reinforcement. This class will give the handler the basic skill to apply this simple philosophy to training their dog for any of the dog performance events, trick training or anything else they chose

Obedience Fun and Games

Entry Requirements: Dogs must have achieved obedience skills to a pre-novice level.

Exit Requirements: Dogs and handlers will develop an enhanced relationship, while reinforcing their basic obedience skills.

Description: This course is designed to build and reinforce skills used in obedience through games and team competition format.

Introduction to Musical Freestyle (Doggie Dancing)

In this introductory course we will teach your dog 20 basic movements that you can use in canine musical freestyle dance routines. Freestyle work assists in building attention and duration skills into any dog sport by using a step by step positive approach.

Agility Trial Prep:

Entry Requirements: Minimum Completion of Agility Level 4 – Introduction to Handling

Description: This class is intended to further develop the team's ability to work independent equipment and distance.
